- Birgunj Metropolitan City has allocated fund toward *the cost* of *Preparation of Integrated Sustainable Development Plan (ISDP) Birgunj Metropolitan City* and intends to apply a portion of this **fund** to eligible payments under the Contract for which this Expression of Interest is invited for *National consulting service*.
- The *Birgunj Metropolitan City* now invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from eligible consulting firms ("consultant") to provide the following consulting services:

Preparation of Integrated Sustainable Development Plan of Birgunj Metropolitan City. Detail of objectives and scope are as per as ToR.

- Interested eligible consultants may obtain further information and EOI document free of cost at the address *Birgunj Metropolitan City*, *Adarshnagar*, *Birgunj* from 2075-11-19 during office hour or for more details visit official website http://www.birgunjmun.gov.np
- Expressions of interest shall be delivered manually to the address Birgunj Metropolitan City, Adarshnagar, Birgunj on or before 2075-12-04, 12:00 PM.
- The consultants may form a Joint Venture (JV) among maximum of three partners only to enhance their qualification and the partnership should not be repeated to other joint ventures.
- In case the last date of obtaining and submission of the EOI documents happens to be a holiday, the next working day will be deemed as the due date but the time will be the same as stipulated.
- EOI will be assessed based on **Qualification 40%**, **Experience 50%**, and **Capacity 10%** of consulting firm/s and key personnel. Based on evaluation of EOI, only shortlisted firms will be invited to submit technical and financial proposal through a request for proposal.
- Minimum score to pass the EOI is 60%.
- *Birgunj Metropolitan City* reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications, or cancel the entire proceedings without giving any reasons, whatsoever.
- Pre-bid meeting will be held 10 days before of last date of submission at 2:00 pm in BMC office.

B. INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

- Expression of Interest may be submitted by a sole firm or a joint venture of consulting firms.
- Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (descriptions, organization and employee and of the firm or company, description of assignments of similar nature completed in the last 7 years and their location, experience in similar conditions, general qualifications and the key personnel to be involved in the proposed assignment).
- This expression of interest is open to all eligible *consulting firms*.
- In case, the applicant is individual consultant, details of similar assignment experience, their location in the previous 3 years and audited balance sheet and bio data shall be considered for evaluation.
- The assignment has been scheduled for a period of *six months from the date of agreement*. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the *QCBS* method.
- Expression of Interest should contain following information:
 - A covering letter addressed to the representative of the client on the official letter head of company duly signed by authorized signatory.

C. Brief TOR

Terms of Reference (TOR) for Preparation of Integrated Sustainable Development Plan (ISDP) of Birgunj Metropolitan City.

1. Background

Most of the cities and regions of Nepal, except Kathmandu Valley and its vicinity, remain deprived of economic growth as well as deliberate investment. The urban centers are already confronting the backlog of infrastructure services. This backlog continues to grow also owing to weak municipal capacity including the limited financial base. Consequently, urban investments remain largely uncoordinated and fragmented and are being channeled to make provisions for basic facilities rather than to strategic projects which would have made greater economic impacts in the region.

On the other hand, potentials/opportunities of the urban centers in the region are not fully examined. Similarly, the role of cities and their inter-linkages in contributing to regional economic growth is less understood and appreciated. Consequently, urban potential as well as complementarities of comparative advantages of cities/towns are less exploited. The resultant is the inability of urban areas to serve as dynamic engines of growth. The implications might be more, outmigration from small urban centers and rural area to the larger cities resulting wider ramification on the quality of life and natural environment of others cities. This trend adds further regional disparity.

The implication would be development of specific/strategic urban infrastructures as well as specialized activities according to specific potential and comparative advantage of a place. This will reduce duplication of investment in the region as well as help optimize the scarce national resource – leading to development of a sustainable urban system within the region. Such system will comprise of cities with complementing urban functions resulting in a self-contained and self-reliant urban economic region.

In this context, with the goal of maintaining balanced urban system, Government of Nepal (GoN) has already initiated development of new towns Similarly Birgunj Metropolitan City is planning for development and improvement in the quality of life of people of the Birgunj city in a sustainable way.

2. Objectives

The main objective of the proposed assignment is to make identified and proposed development projects sustainable in an integrated way. The specific objectives are:

- To find out way of improving revenue of BMC sustainably.
- To conserve and protect environment of BMC for a long period.
- To organize spatial growth of settlements in an appropriate direction in order to provide infrastructure and services to the large number of populace effectively and efficiently.
- To contribute in realizing Sustainable Development Goal number 11 i.e. "Sustainable Cities and Communities" of UN
- To pave a road map of development in different sector with strategy, policy formulation and action plans
- To facilitate in execution of vision of BMC.
- To formulate the integrated sustainable development action plan of the city for ten year horizon that includes guiding policies, strategies, strategic programs/ projects, action plan for each five years periods and development control tools to foster the growth potential of the city.

3. Scope of works

Followings are the scope of work within the assignment:

- To collect reports, Map, data and information related to the assignment as part of desk study.
- To identify key Sustainable Development Indicators/issues.
- To analyze the key priority economic, environmental, cultural and social issues consisting primarily, demography, heritage, cultural/social harmony, GESI, trade and commerce; health, education, sanitation, pollution, drainage, greenery, solid waste management etc.
- To analyze opportunities and constraints for spatial development for settlements with due consideration of disaster risks and different development/economic potentials, area of comparative advantages of the area.
- To analyze physical infrastructure and services comprising mainly of road, communication, sewer, transport, security, fire
- Financial analysis consisting of revenue generation of municipality.
- Sustainable development potential analysis
- To carryout SWOT analysis in line with sustainable development concept.
- To assess role and function of the city in the region/province,
- To assess the state and trends of sustainable development (SD) issues.
- To Identify specific five key priority issues in social, economic, physical/spatial and environmental sectors and analyze those identifying gaps and challenges to be addressed in the action plan.
- To assess preliminary effect of climate change.
- Assessment of disaster risk reduction practices.
- To identify thematic development opportunities on social, economic. Physical/spatial and environment in line with the Metropolitan Sustainable Development vision and priority.
- To frame and prepare outlines of infrastructure, social, economic and other related projects which are substantial to meet the objective of this assignment.
- To assess and prepare/endorse/ propose for amendment policies, strategies for sustainable development of identified sectors.
- To prepare the sustainable development information system to monitor the ISDP based on the indicator;

4. Approach and Methodology:

4.1 The approach

The preparation of the ISDP shall be based on available credible scientific data and indicator. The first phase of preparation of the ISDP is to conduct collection and assessment of the available collected information and consultation with the stakeholders of the Birgunj Metropolitan city to identify the Sustainable Development Vision and identify the key five priority issues in economic, environmental and social sectors. The identified priority issues shall/can be analyzed using the DPSIR framework (Drivers, Pressure, State, Impact and Response) to identify the gaps and need which will help in preparing project and plan in addressing the gaps and needs considering in achieving SD vision of the Metropolitan. Based on the consultation and analysis of the SD priority issues a Sustainable development plan will be prepared on various sector.

After development of Draft report content & identifying the key priority issues from workshop, the collected information from the desk study will be used to develop the draft report by analyzing the identified issues using DPSIR framework. The needed further information for the preparation of the first draft of ISDP will be collected from the concern office. Dissemination event shall be organised to inform the outputs of the study.

4.2 Information / feedback / data collection:

After preparing checklist, relevant information and/or data shall be collected by applying following methods:

- Questionnaire survey, interview with stakeholders and field observation to collect primary data.
- Relevant literatures and documents, as secondary information, shall be collected by visiting concerned agencies.
- Spatial data shall be collected by secondary information and satellite image or other source. However, it shall be verified to the extent possible, by field visit.
- Organize consultation workshop to identify key pressing Sustainable development (economical, environmental and Social) issues of the Birgunj Metropolitan City by inviting Metropolitan, ward office official and key personality and stakeholders who can contribute in identifying the key issues and in development of the content of the report

4.3 Existing situation and date analysis:

Analysis of data shall be done by manually and also by using computer software viz. SPSS, MS Excel and other relevant tools. The interrelation among the various variables shall be thoroughly analysed. Graphical methods may also be utilized to do the analysis.

4.4 Maps and / or Drawings preparation:

Secondary information such as cadastral maps, satellite imagery, topographical maps and other relevant maps prepared by various agencies shall be used for preparing base maps. No

topographical survey shall be carried out. Maps/Drawings/Plans shall be prepared by taking reference of satellite image with the application of GIS software, Auto Cad software. Google image, open source maps can be extensively used. If necessary, field measurement shall be carried out for the places or situations where accuracy is required. Other relevant drawings shall also be prepared by using the similar program. If specific details have to be prepared, those shall be done by using software like Studio Max, Sketch up, Form G etc. free hand sketches.
